LEGEND

- Group S Short-day hikers are generally back in early afternoon, drives are shorter (usually less than 45 minutes), up to 5 mi (slower pace)
- M Medium-day hikers are gone most of the day, drive time is often 1- 2 hr, 5 to 9 mi (medium pace)
- L Long-day group may not be back until 6:00, often none of the hikers have been on that trail before, up to 15 mi (faster pace)
- P Progressive hikes that increase ~1 mi every 2 weeks throughout the season
